1. Report on Financial Statements :

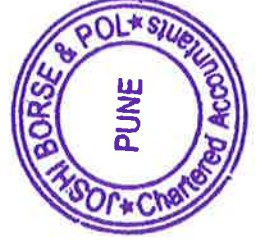
